Policy

- **1. Build Back Better (**Where earthen bricks have collapsed, those made of stones will replace them.)
- **2. Create better opportunities** boosting the country's socioeconomic.
- 3. Managing as minimize risk as possible.
- **4. Enhancing response activities** to mitigate the impact of disaster.
- 5. Enhancing the spirit of self-reliance of the victim of disaster.
- **6. Encouraging the psycho social support** of the victim to cure the nightmare of disaster.

Legislation

• The Natural Disaster Management Law with (9) Chapters has been ratified by Parliament on 31st July 2013.

Objectives

- (a) **to implement** natural disaster management programmes **systematically and expeditiously** in order to reduce disaster risks:
- (b) to form the National Committee and Local Bodies in order to implement natural disaster management programmes systematically and expeditiously;
- (c) to coordinate with national and international government departments and organizations, social organizations, other non-government organizations or international organizations and regional organizations in carrying out natural disaster management activities;

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
Legislation

- (d) to conserve and restore the environment affected by natural disaster;
- (e) to provide health, education, social and livelihood programmes in order to bring about better living conditions for victims.

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Disaster Recovery Activities

The Disaster Management Law was ratified by Pyidaungsu Hluttaw on 31 July 2013 and according to the section 18 of disaster management law , post disaster rehabilitation and reconstruction activities are as follows,

- Damage and loss assessment and confirmation.
- Continuous support of adequate amount of food, relief items and rehabilitation and reconstruction materials and funding.
- Set up and implement the rehabilitation and reconstruction action
 plan based on the situation of damage and losses.

- The building which are damaged Relocate and Reconstruct in safer place and resilience.
- Implementing Recovery programme on agriculture, livestock and fisheries and livelihood sectors to reach normal situation
- Implementing psychosocial support project for the victim who suffer from disaster programme who suffer from disaster and impact on their mentality
- Making effort on health care service and preventive measures on infectious diseases follow by disaster

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- Building School and making action plan for continuous
 learning for the students in disaster affected community
- Managing the effective security, prevalence of law and order
- Collaborating with concerned organization to prevent human trafficking
- Implementing rehabilitation and reconstruction related activities according to Disaster Management Law.





- To establish Disaster Management Training Center in Ayeyarwaddy Region.
- To upgrade Emergency Operation Center.
- To implement the ongoing projects to achieve MAPDRR Goal.
