## UNDAC – United Nations Disaster Assessment and Coordination

*Assists Governments and the UN with on-site coordination during the first phase of an emergency*

*As of January 2007 more than 150 missions to over 80 countries*

*More than 150 experienced emergency managers from more than 60 countries and organizations*

*Preparedness missions in order to assess capacities and make recommendations for improved effectiveness of response systems*



### **INSARAG – International Search and Rescue Advisory Group**

*A global network of more than 80 countries and organizations focussing on urban search and rescue*

*Aims to establish standards and classification for international USAR teams as well as methodology for international response coordination*

*As the INSARAG secretariat OCHA organizes regional group meetings and exercises to assist in capacity building for regional response preparedness*



### **CADRI – Capacity for Disaster Reduction Initiative**

*A joint programme for UNDP/BCPR, the ISDR secretariat and OCHA to reflect the broader dimensions of Disaster Risk Reduction, including advocacy, policy development, governance, preparedness and recovery*

#### ***Areas of support include:***

- *Tools and materials*
- *Institutional strengthening*
- *Advisory Services*
- *Information and access to resources*
- *Exchange, Partnerships and Network Development*
- *Promotion of Disaster Risk Reduction in higher education*
- *Methodologies for capacity development in DRR planning*



#### Advisory Services

CADRI will provide or facilitate the provision of:

1. Country level, capacity development planning for national strategies and programmes.
2. Measures for monitoring, evaluating and reporting capacity development progress.
3. Processes for national consensus building for disaster risk reduction priority setting.
4. Regional and country level curriculum development planning in higher education/tertiary education for disaster risk reduction.
5. A Leadership Development Programme for UN Resident Coordinators related to their disaster risk reduction roles

#### Materials, Tools, Methodologies

CADRI will identify, collate, adapt and develop materials and tools to:

1. Address the HFA, priority one- Making disaster risk reduction a priority, and priority five –Strengthening disaster preparedness for effective response, through elaboration of guides, such as *Words Into Action*.
2. Measure and report on progress of capacity development.
3. Establish an electronic resource library on capacity development.
4. Develop Disaster Reduction Curriculum/Subject Material and Reference Compendium.
5. Train facilitators for capacity development planning advisory services.

#### Network Development

CADRI will facilitate the formation of:

1. A network for knowledge sharing and capacity strengthening of learning and training practitioners and organizations.
2. A network of academic and higher education institutions engaged in disaster risk reduction.
3. A cadre of facilitators to provide country level advisory services for capacity development planning, monitoring and reporting progress.
4. A cadre of regional disaster risk reduction curriculum advisors for Africa, Asia, and the Americas.
5. A list serv. working group, June 2007, for further involvement with CADRI.
