


Aims

Certain topics will be decided every year in accordance with Priorities 1-5 of the Hyogo Framework for Action (HFA).

Flow of the Project (2009)

1. ADRC invited application

(2 target countries & 4 reviewer countries)



2. ADRC selected 2 target countries & 4 reviewer countries



3. Target countries Submitted country reports



4. Reviewer teams visited target countries and conducted interview survey

Flow of the Project (2009)

5. Each reviewer team compiled a draft survey report



6. Draft survey reports were sent to target countries



7. Survey reports will be shared among member countries




8. Target countries are expected to utilise the report for further implementation of HFA

Review Method

- **Country reports** submitted by target countries
- **On site (interview) survey** at relevant organisations such as governmental agencies, international organisations, NGOs, academic institutions, etc.

 - Summary of Country Report of target countries
 - Overview of the mission
 - mission schedule, members, organisations visited.
 - Observation & Analysis
 - “Strengths” & “Weaknesses”
 - Findings and recommendations from reviewers
- *Full Country Report of target country is also attached.
