With the population of **5.8 mln. people of more than 100 nationalities**, **Kyrgyzstan** is known as a country of great mountains, picturesque high-mountains rivers and lakes, magnificent waterfalls, healing springs and green generous valleys.





Over 90% of the territory of the Kyrgyz Republic are located more than 1,500 m. above the sea level





MOST DANGEROUS NATURAL PROCESSES







Majority of the big cities and rural settlements of the country are located within area of the potential earthquake centers, which intensity can reach **9 and more points according to MSK-64.**

About 75% of the population of the republic resides there.

RESULTS OF SAFETY ASSESSMENT OF SCHOOLS, PRESCHOOLS

General safety assessment for schools and pre-schools by three



Budget financing on prevention and liquidation of emergency situations is **6 million \$ USA**

Annual direct damage from emergency situations **30 – 35 million \$ USA**

Approx. **200** emergencies annually

The real scale of damage, losses and needs for recovering and reconstructing everything that suffered from disasters is actually significantly larger.

Financial and material losses from emergency situations exceed real possibilities of system of protection the population more than **in 5 times**.



At the current stage, having headed towards sustainable development, Kyrgyzstan considers disaster risks reduction as one of the crucial state functions, a component to ensuring national security of the Kyrgyz Republic.

Kyrgyzstan has achieved significant progress in implementing Hyogo Framework for Action 2005-2015 on the key priorities in building resilience of Nations and Communities to Disasters.

Priority 2. Enhance capacity of public governance bodies and local governments in assessing and monitoring disaster risks and perfecting early warning system

1. The State Program for Comprehensive monitoring and forecast of dangerous natural processes subject to geoinformation technologies and remote zoning 2015-2017

2. Establishment of Single Database on landslides in Kyrgyzstan linked to locations (using GPS)

3. Technical manual on damage, losses and needs assessment in the Kyrgyz Republic.

4. GeoNod is launched (Data platform about disaster risks)

5. Hydrometeorological service is being upgraded in the Kyrgyz Republic

6. Draft Disaster Risk Assessment Manual for local governments



Priority No. 3. Enhance understanding and awareness of communities and state officials on disaster risk management

1. DRR, safety matters are introduced in educational and training process in schools and pre-schools, the relevant training materials developed





2. Efforts are invested in the enhancement of preparedness among children in schools and kindergartens to possible emergencies and in disaster risk reduction on the basis of educational institutions.









Priority 4. Hold preventive activities (structural mitigation) for disaster risk reduction.

Coordination of strengthening DRR cooperation at the international and regional levels

□ In conjunction with UNDP, UNISDR, the Government of Japan under "Central Asia plus Japan" Dialogue, the implementation of measures aimed at the strengthening of regional DRR cooperation by establishing the Forum of the heads of Central Asian emergency agencies, international expert work groups, framework for the strengthening of regional DRR cooperation in Central Asia and South Caucasus, as well as Action Plans for their implementation;

□ Enhanced cooperation with the National DRR Platform in Germany, Armenia, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan and other countries;

□ Expanded and strengthened cooperation with international, regional and subregional institutions and hubs.





The Delegation of the Kyrgyz Republic supports the Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction for the period after 2015 in its entirety.

Voluntary intentions and key commitments for the period after 2015:

- Enhance policy and strategy perfection activities at all levels, as well as enhance DRR knowledge and shared experience;
- Facilitate strengthening DRR coordination activities engaging all stakeholders at the regional, national and local levels;
- * Build partnership with all stakeholders in order to ensure sustainable development by mitigating disaster threats, including those related to climate change

Voluntary intentions and key commitments for the period after 2015 : Enhance coordination of DRR activities carried out by all stakeholders and at all levels, giving emphasis to local level in the following priorities :

- 1. awareness of disaster risks;
- 2. strengthening management system and institutions for the regulation of disaster threats;
- 3. investment in ensuring economic, social, cultural and environmental stability;
- 4. increased preparedness for efficient response and identification of the best recovery and reconstruction activities.

Key DDR goals of the State Civil Protection System of the Kyrgyz Republic

1. Further perfect SCPS regulatory framework

2. Implement the 2nd roll out stage of the Single Information Management System of the Kyrgyz Republic

3. Build national and local capacity for emergency response

4. Develop state hazardous natural processes comprehensive monitoring and forecasting system based on SIS

5. Make further efforts to enhance understanding and awareness of people and state DRR officials

6. Perfect slow risks assessment, monitoring and forecasting system (drought and lack of water)

7. Work on the development of regulatory framework for the establishment of Civil Protection Institute

8. Hold preventive activities, including the actions to ensure the safety of schools and kindergartens.
