

PHILIPPINES DISASTER RISK PROFILE







Historical Perspective (43 years)

From 1970 - 2015, a total of 890 Tropical Cyclones (TCs) entered the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR). Three hundred thirty-three (333) of these TCs were considered destructive (average of 7 TCs annually) in terms of the following:






- Mainstreaming of DRR and CCA in the Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP)
