SUMMARY OF IMPORTANT EVENTS AS ON 02.07.2012

# **RAINFALL/FLOOD SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY**

Rainfall occurred at many places over Kerala, Lakshadweep, north coastal Andhra Pradesh and Chhattisgarh, at a few places over Vidarbha and Arunachal Pradesh and at one or two places over Himachal Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathwada, Karnataka, Telangana, Orissa, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, Bihar, Assam & Meghalaya, Manipur and Mizoram. Weather remained mainly dry over rest parts of the Country. The chief amounts of rainfall (2cm or more) recorded at 1730 hours IST of yesterday were: Champa-6, Nagpur-5, Kailashahar-3 and Kurnool, Honavar, Tuni, Wardha and Vengurla-2 each.

# **Indian Meteorological Department (Major features of weather forecast)**

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Maharashtra, Karnataka, Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Orissa, South Chhattisgarh and north Andhra Pradesh.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Gujarat region, south Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal & Sikkim and northeastern states.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over Bihar, Jharkhand, north Chhattisgarh, north Madhya Pradesh and east Uttar Pradesh during next 24 hours and increase thereafter.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over rest parts of the country.
- Maximum temperature would fall by 2.4° C over Uttar Pradesh, east Rajasthan, east and central India during next 2-3 days.

There are 04 Moderate flood situation sites in the country as on 02.07.2012.

# **DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF)**

➤ 15 Teams consisting of 514 personnel of NDRF have been deployed in Assam –12, Andhra Pradesh – 01 and J&K-02.

## INDIAN METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT (daily weather report)

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Maharashtra, Karnataka, Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Orissa, South Chhattisgarh and north Andhra Pradesh.

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Gujarat region, south Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal & Sikkim and northeastern states.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over Bihar, Jharkhand, north Chhattisgarh, north Madhya Pradesh and east Uttar Pradesh during next 24 hours and increase thereafter.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over rest parts of the country.
- Maximum temperature would fall by 2.4° C over Uttar Pradesh, east Rajasthan, east and central India during next 2-3 days.

# **Weather Warning**

• Heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Konkan & Goa, coastal Karnataka, Telangana, coastal Andhra Pradesh, south Chhattisgarh and Orissa during next 48 hours.

# Weather outlook for next two days

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over west coast, east and adjoining central India and northeastern states.
- Increase in rainfall activity over northwest India.

# <u>CENTRAL WATER COMMISSION (daily water levels and forecasts for level at forecast sites)</u>

According to the Central Water Commission (CWC) report dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2012, there are 04 Moderate flood situation sites in the country, as per details given below:-

## **Moderate Flood Site**

#### **Assam**

- ➤ River Brahmaputra at Neamatighat in district Jorhat, Assam is flowing at 85.16 m against the danger level of 85.04 m with falling trend.
- ➤ River Brahmaputra at Goalpara in district Goalpara, Assam is flowing at 36.42 m against the danger level of 36.27 m with falling trend.
- ➤ River Brahamputra at Dhubri in District Dhubri, Assam is flowing at 29.55m against the danger level of 28.62m with falling trend.
- ➤ River Kopili at Dharmatul at district Morigaon, Assam is flowing at 56.03m against the danger level of 56.00m with falling trend.

## DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF) ON 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2012.

- ❖ In Assam, 09 teams of 1<sup>st</sup> Bn, NDRF consisting of 314 personnel (Kamrup-18, Tinsukia-71, Sonitpur -182 and Dhemaji-43) and 03 teams of 2<sup>nd</sup> Bn NDRF consisting of 106 personnel (Majuli Island, Jorhat-70 and Nagaon/Kamrup -36) deployed in connection with flood relief and rescue.
- ❖ In Andhra Pradesh, 01 team of 5<sup>th</sup> Bn NDRF consisting of 15 personnel in Guntur along with necessary equipments for emergency and also imparting DM training to personnel of 10 Bn, NDRF.

❖ In J&K, 02 teams of 7 BN NDRF consisting of 79 personnel deployed in Pahalgam (J&K) for FAMEX & Amarnath Yatra duty.
