Subject: **SOUTHWEST MONSOON-2012: DAILY FLOOD SITUATION REPORT  
SUMMARY OF IMPORTANT EVENTS AS ON 09.07.2012**

**RAINFALL/FLOOD SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY**

Rainfall has occurred at most places over Uttar Pradesh, and east Madhya Pradesh; at many places over Himachal Pradesh, west Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, coastal Karnataka, Kerala, Gujurat region, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Lakshadweep, Orissa, West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland, Manipur & Tripura and coastal Andhra Pradesh; at a few places over Uttarakhand, east Rajasthan, Bihar, Telangana and Meghalaya and at one or two places over Punjab, Jharkhand, interior Uttarakhand, east Rajasthan, Bihar, Telangana and Meghalaya and at one or two places over Punjab, Jharkhand, interior Karnataka, Saurashtra, coastal Tamilnadu, Jharkhand and Rayalaseema. Weather remained mainly dry over remaining parts of the country.

**Indian Meteorological Department (Major features of weather forecast)**

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over west coast, Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Orissa, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, central and northeast India.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Uttar Pradesh and Bihar during next 48 hours and increase thereafter.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at few places over east Rajasthan, Gujarat region, Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathawada, interior Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and at one or two places over rest parts of the country.

**CENTRAL WATER COMMISSION (daily water levels and forecasts for level forecast sites)**

- There are 02 Moderate flood situation sites in the country as on 09.07.2012.

**DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF)**

- 18 Teams consisting of 642 personnel of NDRF have been deployed in Assam -14, Andhra Pradesh - 01, J&K-02 and Jharkhand-01.

## **INDIAN METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT (daily weather report)**

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over west coast, Lakshadweep and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Orissa, Jharkhand, West Bengal & Sikkim, central and northeast India.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Uttar Pradesh and Bihar during next 48 hours and increase thereafter.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at few places over east Rajasthan, Gujarat region, Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Madhya Maharashtra, Marathawada, interior Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh and at one or two places over rest parts of the country.

### **Weather Warning**

- Heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Karnataka, Lakshadweep, Kerala, Konkan & Gao and Orissa during next 48 hours.

### **Weather outlook for next two days**

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over west coast, east India, north-eastern states and western Himalayan region and at a few places over central India.

## **CENTRAL WATER COMMISSION (daily water levels and forecasts for level at forecast sites)**

According to the Central Water Commission (CWC) report dated 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2012, there are 02 Moderate flood situation sites in the country, as per details given below:-

### **Moderate Flood Site**

#### **Assam**

- River Brahmaputra at Neamatighat in District Jorhat, Assam is flowing at 85.45m against the danger level of 85.04 m with Falling trend.
- River Brahmaputra at Dhubri in District Dhubri, Assam is flowing at 28.65m against the danger level of 28.62m with rising trend.

## **DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF) ON 9<sup>th</sup> July, 2012.**

- ❖ In Assam, 14 teams of 1<sup>st</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> NDRF consisting of 508 personnel (Kamrup-30, Sivasagar-34, Tinsukia-37, Sonitpur-200, Dhemaji-43, Dhubri-50, Barpeta-44, Jorhat-35, Nagaon-35) deployed in connection with flood relief/rescue, training and emergency response.
- ❖ In Andhra Pradesh, 01 team of 5<sup>th</sup> Bn NDRF consisting of 15 personnel in Guntur along with necessary equipments for emergency response.
- ❖ In J&K, 02 teams of 7 BN NDRF consisting of 84 personnel deployed in Pahalgam (J&K) for FAMEX & Amarnath Yatra duty.
- ❖ In Jharkhand, 01 team of 2<sup>nd</sup> Bn NDRF consisting of 35 personnel deployed at District Deograh for FAMEX and emergency response during Sawan Mela.
