Subject:SOUTHWEST MONSOON-2012: DAILY FLOOD SITUATION REPORTSUMMARY OF IMPORTANT EVENTS AS ON 16.07.2012

RAINFALL/FLOOD SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY

Rainfall occurred at many places over Konkan, coastal Karnataka, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Bihar, Orissa, West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh and Manipur; at a few places over Madhya Maharashtra, Vidarbha and south coastal Andhra Prades and at one or two places over Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, northwest and east Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat region, Saurashtra, Marathawada, Nagaland, Tripura, interior Karnataka, Tamilnadu, Telangana, Rayalaseema and Lakshadweep. Weather remained mainly dry over rest parts of the country. The chief amounts of rainfall (2 cm and above) recorded at 1730 hours IST of yesterday were: Cherrapunji-16, Passighat-11, Bilaspur-4, Gannavaram, Krishna nagar, Varanasi, Sidhi, Sheopur and Shillong-3 each, Agumbe, Patna, Daltongunj, Churk, Rangia, Majbhat and Chandrapur-2 each.

Indian Meteorological Department (Major features of weather forecast)

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, northeastern states and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over west coast, Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Orissa, Vidarbha, east Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Tamilnadu and Lakshadweep.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over western Himalayan region during next 24 hours and decrease thereafter.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Punjab, Haryana & Delhi, west Uttar Pradesh, east Rajasthan, Gujarat region, Marathawada, Madhya Maharashtra and interior Karnataka.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over west Rajasthan and Saurashtra & Kutch.

There are 08 Moderate flood situation sites in the country as on 16.07.2012.

DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF)

23 Teams consisting of 802 personnel of NDRF have been deployed in Assam –16, Andhra Pradesh – 01, Jharkhand – 01, J&K-02 and Bihar-03.

INDIAN METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT (daily weather report)

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, northeastern states and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over west coast, Gangetic West Bengal, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Orissa, Vidarbha, east Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Tamilnadu and Lakshadweep.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over western Himalayan region during next 24 hours and decrease thereafter.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Punjab, Haryana & Delhi, west Uttar Pradesh, east Rajasthan, Gujarat region, Marathawada, Madhya Maharashtra and interior Karnataka.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over west Rajasthan and Saurashtra & Kutch.

Weather Warning

- Heavy to very heavy rainfall would occur at a few places with isolated extremely heavy falls (>=25 cm) over Su Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim, Assam & Meghalaya and Arunachal Pradesh during next 48 hours.
- Heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura,East Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Gangetic West Bengal, Orissa, Chhattisgarh and Andaman & Nicobar Islands during next 48 hours.

Weather outlook for next two days

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over northeast & east India and east Uttar Pradesh.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many place over central India, west coast & western Himalayan region.

- River Brahamputra at Dhubri in District Dhubri, Assam is flowing at 28.87m against the danger level of 28.62m with Rising trend.
- River Jiabharali at Jiabharali(NTX) in District Sonitpur/Balipara, Assam is flowing at 77.78m against the danger level of 77.00m with Rising trend.
- River Beki at Beki NHX in District Barpeta/Sorbhog, Assam is flowing at 45.24m against the danger level of 45.10 with Rising trend. Bihar
- River Kosi at Basua in District Supaul, Bihar is flowing at 48.16 m against the danger level of 47.75 m with Falling trend.
- River Kamla Balan at Jhanjharpur in District Madhubani/Jhanjharpur, Bihar is flowing at 50.90 m against the danger level of 50.00 m with Falling trend.
- River Mahananda at Dhengraghat in District Purnia/Bayasi, Bihar is flowing at 36.11 m against the danger level of 35.65 m with Rising trend.

<u>West Bengal</u>

River Tista at Domohani in District Jalpaiguri, West Bengal is flowing at 86.30 m against the danger level of 85.95 m with Rising trend.

DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF) ON 16th July, 2012.
