I. CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS

As of 6 August 2012, the Southwest Monsoon "Habagat" was enhanced by the Tropical Storm "Haikui" located at Northeast of Taiwan. The "Habagat" eventually brought heavy rains in Central and South Luzon on the next day. PAGASA recorded 323 mm of rainfall in the first 24 hours from 6 to 7 August 2012.

Flooding occurred mostly in NCR and Region III and IV-A. Respective LGUs spearheaded evacuation, rescue and relief operations.

The Habagat weakened slightly on 8 August 2012, but the following day experienced intense rainfall (16.2mm/hr) over Quezon City, moderate to heavy rainfall (2.5-7.5 mm/hr) was observed over Caloocan, Novaliches, Pasay, Manila, Pasig and Marikina, while light to moderate rainfall (1.0-7.0 mm/hr) over the rest of Metro Manila. The Habagat continued bringing widespread rains and devastation over Northern and Central Luzon, compelling several LGUs to declare a State of Calamity.

To date, the munipalities of Bustos, Calumpit, Hagonoy, Marilao, San Miguel, and Obando in Bulacan are still submerged in floods.

II. SITUATION OVERVIEW

A. Effects

1. Incidents Monitored (TAB A)

• <u>Twenty (20)</u> incidents were monitored – **eight (8)** drowning, **six (6)** landslides, and others being vehicular, collapsed structure, electrocution, flooding and maritime.

2. Affected Population (TAB B)

- The total number of population affected in 2,404 Barangays / 170 Municipalities / 36 Cities in 16 Provinces of Regions I, III, IV-A, IV-B, VI and NCR is: <u>761,189 families /</u> <u>3,457,774 persons</u>.
- To date, <u>205,835 families / 970,296 persons</u> are currently served inside and outside evacuation centers.

Inside <u>810</u> Evacuation Centers (ECs) Outside ECs (relatives/friends) 74,930 families / 341,915 persons 130,905 families / 628,381 persons

 The total number of evacuation centers gradually decreases as the weather situation improves. The total number of families/persons inside the evacuation centers decreases while the total number of families/persons outside the evacuation centers has increased for some families/perons opted to go back to their respective houses.

3. Casualties (TAB C)

- As of 6:00 PM, 13 August 2012, a total of <u>ninety five (95)</u> persons were reported dead: twelve (12) were victims of landslide, sixty nine (69) drowning, twelve (12) landslide, two (2) lightning stike, four (4) electrocution, three (3) heart attack / cardiac arrest, one (1) nervous breakdown, two (2) fallen trees and two (2) undertermined cause.
- To date, the four (4) victims of drowning remains to be unidentified.
- A total of **eleven (11)** persons were injured due to landslide, vehicular accident and snake bite.
- A total of four (4) persons are still missing while 62,846 were rescued.

4. Status of Lifelines

- 1. Condition of Roads and Bridges (TAB D)
- A total of <u>eleven (11)</u> roads and <u>three (3)</u> bridges are not passable to all types of vehicles in Regions I, III, IV-A and CAR due to flooding.
- As of 6:00 PM, 13 August 2012, the roads in San Isidro, Sta Monica and San Luis, Bataan are already passable while the Bayambang-Camiling Road in Ilocos Sur is under repair.

2. Status of Dams and Waterways (As of 6:00 PM, 12 August 2012)

- The water from Ipo Dam is likely to affect the low-lying areas along the Angat River. All residents living in those areas are advised to be alert for possible increase in water level downstream and to take precautionary measures.
- All residents living in the areas near the Angat, Ipo, Ambuklao, Binga, San Roque and Magat are advised to be alert for possible increase in the water level downstream.

F. Damaged Houses (TAB E)

• A total of <u>8,629 houses</u> were damaged in Regions I, III, IV-A, IV-B and VI, of which <u>2,996 totally</u> and <u>5,633 partially</u> damaged.

G. Cost of Damages (TAB F)

- As of 6:00 PM, 13 August 2012, The total cost of damages to infrastructure and agriculture in Regions I, III, IV-A, IV-B and NCR is ₱ 2,263,539,045.14.
- The total cost of damages to infrastructure is <u>▶ 639,128,230.00</u> and the total cost of damages to agriculture is <u>▶ 1,624,410,815.14</u>.
- There is a significant increase in the cost of damage in agriculture (fisheries) in Region III.

H. Flooded Areas (TAB G)

- A total of sixty four (64) Cities/Municipalities from NCR, Regions III, and IV-A have flooding.
- The flooding in Region I has been subsided while there are reported floodings in some Brgys in Pampanga.

I. Suspension of Classes (As of 13 August 2012)

• Classes in Hagonoy (Pre-School to High School) and Meycauyan, Bulacan (Brgys. Longos and Zamora, All Levels) are suspended.

III. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

A. Conduct of Emergency Cabinet Meeting

- The NDRRMC conducted an Emergency Meeting with His Excellency President Benigno Aquino III at 10:00 AM, 7 August 2012 at the NDRRMC Conference Room, attended by DSWD, DILG, DOST (PAGASA), MMDA, DPWH, DOH, and DepEd, AFP, PNP, BFP, PCG, other agencies and print / broadcast media. The meeting focused on the action plan on damage assessment, asset mobilization, Search and Rescue (SAR), relief allocation and distribution to augment the LGUs and affected communities
- The DOST (PAGASA), DSWD, DPWH, MMDA and DOH presented their reports based on their respective mandates
- The President raised some specific issues that need to be addressed by the concerned agencies. Likewise provided general guidance to the response and relief agencies to require the LGUs concerned to go around their respective areas through the Brgy Captains and provide necessary assistance whenever necessary
- President's instructions to the agencies were the following: <u>DSWD</u> to find a place where they can put tents as additional evacuation centers; <u>DOH</u> to initiate the provision of water for those who depend on deep wells and how to address flooding in hospitals; <u>DILG</u> to identify all inundated /flooded Barangays in Marikina City affected by SW Monsoon, require all LGUs to go around their areas through the barangay captains; and check floodings in Tarlac and Northern Luzon (La Union. Pangasinan and llocos; DOST to fast track the preparation of hazard map of Luzon. <u>DPWH</u> to study the long term solution for Laguna Lake.
- On 8 August, 2012, His Excellency President Benigno Aquino III, DND Secretary and NDRRMC Chairperson Voltaire Gazmin, MMDA Chairperson Francis Tolentino and Muntinlupa City Mayor Aldrin San Pedro personally inspected the Tunasan Elementary School in Brgy Tunasan, Muntinlupa City to assess the situation of the evacuees.
- The President then proceeded to the NDRRMOC for a short briefing with the NDRRMC TWG and discussed the current weather situation and forecast, roads accessibility and response measures being implemented.
- An aerial damage assessment was conducted by OCD Operations Division Dir. Armando Duque together with PAGASA representatives Deputy Administrator Vic Malano, Mr. Mario Raymundo, and Mr. Bernie de Leon.

B. Relief and Recovery Operations

DSWD:

• Prepositioned P3.31 million standby funds and P38.32 million worth of relief supplies in all DSWD-FOs along the typhoon path, amounting to P41.64 million.

- DROMIC is closely coordinating with DSWD-FOs concerned for any significant updates related to SW monsoon.
- Affected families need food, water, clothing, mats, blankets, and diapers for infants

DOH-HEMS:

- Closely monitors the status of health services, offices and personnel at all levels; strengthen advisory and health promotion campaign on the preventive measures of Leptospirosis case and other food and water borne related diseases; and released assorted drugs and medicines and rubber boots to CHDs.
- CHDs I, III, IV-A,, IV-B, CAR and NCR provided assorted drugs and medicines to the LGUs concerned.
- Code Red Alert is still raised.
- Activation and monitoring of Surveillance in Post Extreme Emergencies and Disaster (SPEED) reports from different health facilities in Regions III, IV-A, and NCR.

DepEd:

• Reported that 51 schools so far are being utilized as evacuation centers; mobilized teachers to conduct classes in QC; and prepare contingency plan (1-2 hrs additional for regular classes) to complete 180 days mandatory or make up classes.

DILG:

- Provided assistance by search and rescue (SAR) and evacuation in the municipalities of Batangas namely: Calaca, Calatagan, Lemery, Lian, Taal, Tuy, Bauan, San Luis, Agoncillo, Alitagtag, Cuenca, Laurel, Malvar, San Nicolas, Sta Teresita, Talisay, Tanauan City
- Provincial Engineering Office mobilized heavy equipment (loader, backhoe and dumptrucks) to augment in the clearing operations in the affected barangays of Lemery.
- Issued a memorandum addressed to all DILG Provincial/City Directors for the reactivation of the Local Price Coordinating Councils to ensure that all LCE's adopt measures to address hoarding and exorbitant price increases of essential/prime commodities.

C. Cost of Assistance (TAB H)

- A total amount of ₱ 94,882,408.26 worth of relief assistance was provided to the affected families. The Local Government Units (LGUs) provided ₱ 40,206,540.12, Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) provisioned ₱ 5,515,515.78. Department of Health granted ₱ 13,209,614.26, while the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) allocated ₱ 35,950,738.04.
- Region III and NCR received remains to have the biggest allocation to date.

D. Search and Rescue (SAR) Operations (TAB I)

- SAR operations were effected through the concerted efforts of the SAR units of AFP, PCG and PNP and around 19,200 personnel, 678 vehicles and 435 seacrafts were mobilized to various areas in Metro Manila.
- LTO allocated 43 personnels, 5 vehicles and 4 seacrafts for SAR Operations.
