Subject: SOUTHWEST MONSOON-2012: DAILY FLOOD SITUATION REPORT SUMMARY OF IMPORTANT EVENTS AS ON 30.09.2012.

RAINFALL/FLOOD SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY

Rainfall occurred at many places over coastal Andhra Pradesh and Andaman and Nicobar Islands; at a few places over northeastern states, Odisha, Chhattisgarh and Rayalaseema and at one or two places over Uttarakhand, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Konkan & Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, interior Karnataka and Tamilnadu & Puducherry. Weather remained mainly dry over rest part of the country. The chief amounts of rainfall (1 cm and above) recorded at 1730 hours IST of yesterday were: Narsapur-4; Long Island and Lumding-2 each; Bhawanipatha, Hirakund, Kalingapatam, Ongole, Kolkata(Alipore) and Ambikapur-1 each.

Indian Meteorological Department (Major features of weather forecast)

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, coastal Tamilnadu & Pudducherry, northeastern states and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Odisha, West Bengal & Sikkim, Jharkhand and Chhattisgarh and over interior Tamilnadu and Kerala during next 48 hours.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over western Himalayan region and Bihar.
- Weather would be mainly dry over rest of the country.

There are 3 Moderate flood situation sites in the country as on 30.09.2012.

DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF)

16 Teams consisting of 444 personnel of NDRF have been deployed in Assam –08, Andhra Pradesh-01, Maharashtra-03 and Bihar-04

INDIAN METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT (daily weather report)

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Karnataka, Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, coastal Tamilnadu & Pudducherry, northeastern states and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Odisha, West Bengal & Sikkim, Jharkhand and Chhattisgarh and over interior Tamilnadu and Kerala during next 48 hours.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over western Himalayan region and Bihar.
- Weather would be mainly dry over rest of the country.

Weather Warning

- Heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Andhra Pradesh, Rayalaseema and north coastal Tamilnadu during next 48 hours.
- Heavy rainfall would occur at one or two places over Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh and interior Karnataka.

Weather outlook for next two days

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over eastern & northeastern states, Chhattisgarh, east Madhya Pradesh and Maharashtra.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over north Karnataka, north Andhra Pradesh and east Uttar Pradesh.

Moderate Flood Site

Assam

➤ River Brahmaputra at Dhubri, district Dhubri, Assam is flowing at 29.14m against the danger level of 28.62m with Falling trend.

Jharkhand

➤ River Ganga at Sahibganj, district Sahibganj, Jharkhand is flowing at 27.41m against the danger level of 27.25m with Falling trend.

West Bengal

➤ River Ganga at Farakka, district Murshidabad, West Bengal is flowing at 22.51m against the danger level of 22.25m with Falling trend.

<u>DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF) ON 30th</u> Sept, 2012.

- ❖ In Assam, 08 teams of 1st NDRF consisting of 232 personnel (Kamrup(02 teams)-48, Dhemaji-34, Sonitpur(02 teams)-64, Tinsukia (03 teams)-86) deployed in connection with flood rescue and relief operations.
- ❖ In Andhra Pradesh, 01 team of 5th Bn NDRF consisting of 15 personnel in Guntur along with necessary equipments for emergency response and also imparting DM training to personnel of 10 Bn, NDRF.
- ❖ In Maharashtra, 03 teams of 5th Bn, NDRF consisting of 95 personnel in Mumbai deployed for monsoon duty.
- ❖ In Bihar 04 teams of 9th Bn NDRF consisting of 102 personnel (Mujjafarpur-27, Supoul- 26, Gopalganj-26 and Darbhanga-23) deployed for emergency response during monsoon season.
