DISASTER REPORTED

Himachal Pradesh:-

Update upto 1700 hrs dated 10.08.2014 regarding the missing 01 Guide and 24 Students in flash flood, Mandi (H.P). 24 dead bodies of students have been retrieved. Rescue operation is continues to retrieve dead body of missing guide.

ODISHA

- Due to rainfall in the catchment areas, River Baitarani has again started rising and has crossed the danger mark at Akhuapada. The present water level at this gauge station stands at 17.88 mtr. Against danger level of 17.83 mtr.
- Discharge from Hirakund Dam in River Mahanadi continues at 4.06 lakh cusec through 24 sluice gates are now open against 50 opened earlier. At 09.00 AM today (10.08.14), discharge at delta head Mundali near Cuttack remained 7.60 lakh cusec.
- Discharge of flood water to the sea is a bit slow due to full moon day.
- 40 breaches have so far occurred in different river embankments.
- An estimated 5.33 lakh population in 517 villages remain marooned today (forenoon).

- Rainfall is continuing in different parts of the state. Temporary shelter arrangement is being made for the people who have taken shelter on embankments and other high lands.
- Human casualty has reached 39 which include 15 death during previous phase of flood and 24 deaths during the current phase of flooding from 3rd August, 2014. Out of these, body of one person is yet to be recovered.
