

About 110 types of worldwide well known natural disasters are characteristic to Armenia.

And all these in one region, the area of which composes 29.8 thousand square kms.

It is explained with some reasons , two of which $\,$ I shall $\,$ note now.

The first reason is the complicated relief space. It represents itself an area of drastic mountain chains, valleys and big fluctuations of divided heights. The lowest part above the sea level is about 350metres, and the

highest one is 4.000 meters. In fact the difference of heights in that little area is about 3 500 meters.

Consequently 10 geographical zones exist in the Republic of Armenia because of which existing natural disasters are characteristic to those 10 geographical zones.

The second reason is that the whole area of the Republic of Armenia is located under the active seismic zone.

Armenia is one of those unique areas where historical wealthy data about the regional active earthquakes have been maintained, the time involvement of which composes 2000 years. The historical statistic data concerning the earthquakes with 8-10 intensity strength dates since 782 B.C until the period of Spitak earthquake in 1988.



chronology of the strong earthquakes of the 20-th century



Historical review

1991 December	The Emergency management state administration was established.
1992 January	Economical basis was provided to the Emergency management state administration according to the RA government.
1993 April	The civil protection republic headquarters joined the Emergency management state administration.
1995 July	The Emergency management state administration was renamed Emergency management administration.
1997 October	The Emergency management administration was renamed Emergency management administration under the government of the Republic of Armenia.
1999 April	According to the decision of the RA government structural changes were made in the Emergency management administration.
During 2005	The Emergency management administration under the RA government in the result of the reforms was renamed "Armenian Rescue Service" of the Territorial Management ministry of the Republic of Armenia as a state management body.
During 2005-2006	In the result of some reforms there was adopted Ra law about the "Armenian rescue service" about 23 decisions of RA government in which the activity of the Armenian rescue service was regulated.
