DISASTER MANAGEMENT STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR FLOOD IN

ARCAMANIK SUB-DISTRICT

I INTRODUCTION

As we all know that each year the Arcamanik Sub-district is affected by flood whenever precipitation is high that it has become known as flood area. The flooding is caused by overflowing of the Cijalupang/Cisaranten, Cipagalo and Cikiley rivers, a breach in the embankment, the narrow cross section of the rivers, and the conservation of the upstream land/forest, which has never been optimum. Flood management in these areas are done by the people, both for preventive or repressive actions with help from the SATLAK PB of the Municipality of Bandung through its DM Operational Unit for Arcamanik Sub-district. Such actions include reparation of breached embankment by using sacks filled with earth, excavation of the river, and provision of medications.

The wet season of 1998/1999 was related with the La Nina phenomenon that was predicted to cause more severe natural disasters, especially floods, compared to previous records. This is the reason for the establishment of this Arcamanik Sub-district Standard Operating Procedure for Flood Management; to help future implementation.

II OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSES

The objectives and purposes of flood management is to mitigate annual floods and reduce the suffering of the people due to the flood, both preventively and repressively especially in preparation for the 1998/1999 wet season that is predicted to cause worse floods due to the La Nina phenomenon. The implementation of flood management is integrated and structured with related institutions.

III AIM

The aim of flood management is:

- 1. Mitigation of flood disaster in the Arcamanik Sub-district.
- 2. The reduction or recovery of the victims suffering from the flood, physically and non-physically.

IV REGULATION BASE FOR IMPLEMENTATION

The implementation of flood management is based on the following regulations:

- Decree of The Mayor of the Municipality of Bandung, No. 360/SK.634 Mawil Hansip (District HQ of Civil Defense), December 1st 1998, on the Disaster Management Executive Unit (SATLAK PB) of Bandung Municipality.
- 2. Decree of The Mayor of the Municipality of Bandung, No. 630/SK.638 Mawil Hansip, December 5th 1998, on the Disaster Management Standard Operating Procedure for Bandung Municipality.
- 3. Decree of the Sub-district Chief of Arcamanik No. 360/SK.66-Cam/1998, December 17th 1998, on the establishment of the Disaster Management Operational Unit for Arcamanik Sub-district.

V FLOOD PRONE AREAS

Flood prone areas in Arcamanik Sub-district are located in areas lower that the rivers. In the beginning the rivers are intended to serve as irrigation for rice fields; now it has changed function to being drainage canals even though it can still be used for irrigation purposes. This change is in accord with the development.

The flood prone areas are:

- 1. RW 01, 02, 03, 04, 05, 06, 07, 08, 11, and 12of the Kelurahan Cisaranten Kulon, caused by overflowing or a breach in the embankment of the Cisaranten River.
- 2. RW 03, 04, 05, and 10 of the Kelurahan Cisaranten Bina Harapan, caused by the overflowing or breach in the embankment of the Cijalupang River.
- 3. RW 01 and 02 of the Kelurahan Sukamiskin, caused by the overflowing of the Cikiley River and the accumulation of rain that cannot be conveyed to anywhere.

VI MTIGATION EFFORTS

The mitigation efforts for flood management in the Arcamanik Sub-district are as follows:

1. Kelurahan Level

- a. Before flood disaster
 - 1) Create flood prone map;
 - 2) Prepare the potential of the people/community protection to mitigate flood disasters;
 - 3) Provide counseling for the people on flood disaster management whenever possible;
 - 4) Determine alternative evacuation areas for the flood victims;

b. During flood disaster

- 1) Give early warning to the people in the flood prone areas;
- 2) Evacuate flood disaster victims;
- 3) Search and rescue flood victims;
- 4) Provide first aid to the flood victims;
- 5) Prepare the public kitchen;
- 6) Prepare temporary shelter for the flood victims;
- 7) Secure flooded areas;
- 8) Receive, manage, and distribute aid (food, medicine, clean water, etc.);
- Report the flood to the Sub-district Chief of Arcamanik as the head of the DM Operational Unit.

c. Post flood disaster

- 1) Record the number of victims and estimate the damages;
- 2) Bury the deceased victims;
- 3) Rehabilitate the psychological state of the community, social and public facilities, and residential buildings that were damaged by the flood;
- 4) Transfer the flood victims to safer residential areas;
- 5) Report the flood occurrence and needs to the Sub-district Chief of Arcamanik as the head of the DM Operational Unit.

2. Sub-district Level

- a. Before flood disaster
 - 1) Create a map of flood prone areas;
 - 2) Notify the food prone areas and alternatives for victim evacuation and the potential of community protection at the local kelurahan/village.

- 3) Provide counseling and guidance of the potential of Community Protection Units at flood prone kelurahan/village;
- 4) Provide early warning to the people living in flood prone areas;
- 5) Supply sacks according to the requirements from the people or propose for sack supply from the government of the Bandung Municipality through the SATLAK PB.
- 6) Supply medicine through the Arcamanik and Cicadas Puskesmas.

b. During flood disaster

- 1) Give first aid to the flood victims;
- 2) Prepare the public kitchen;
- 3) Prepare temporary shelter for the flood victims;
- 4) Evacuate the flood victims;
- 5) Secure flooded areas;
- 6) Receive, manage, and distribute aid (food, medicine, clean water, etc.);
- 7) Carry out medical check-up of the flood victims;
- 8) Report the flood to the Sub-district Chief of Arcamanik as the head of the DM Operational Unit.

c. Post flood disaster

- 1) Record the number of victims and estimate the damages;
- 2) Rehabilitate the psychological state of the community, social and public facilities, and residential buildings that were damaged by the flood;
- 3) Relocate the flood victims back to their homes or to safer residential areas;
- 4) Report the flood occurrence and needs to the Sub-district Chief of Arcamanik as the head of the DM Operational Unit.

VII TEMPORARY SHELTER PLAN

The plan for temporary shelter for flood victims in the Arcamanik Sub-district is as follows.

- 1. Kelurahan Cisaranten Kulon:
 - a) The Arcamanik Sub-district office for the people of RW 01 & 02;
 - b) Madrasah (Islamic religious school) of RW 03 for its people;
 - c) The office of Kelurahan Cisaranten Kulon for the people of RW 04 and 05;
 - d) Houses in RW 06 that are secure from the flood and TKA/TPA schools (madrasah) for the people of RW 06;

- e) Badminton sports hall for the people of RW 07;
- f) The YPP building for the people of RW 08;
- g) Houses in RW 11 and 12 that are secure from the flood or, if necessary, the office of DIPARDA for the province of West Java for the people of RW 11 and 12.

2. Kelurahan Cisaranten Bina Harapan:

The people of RW 03, 04, and 05 that suffer from the flood may go to their temporary shelter at the RW 03 office building, houses in RW 03 and 05 that are secure from the flood, or set up tents in the free spaces available in RW 05. The people of RW 10 can go to Madrasah At Taqwa or the Bina Harapan Primary School.

3. Kelurahan Sukamiskin

The flood victims of RW 01 and 02 may go to the residential area of PT. Sari Mas (to the houses not yet sold/used) or the office of the Sukamiskin Lurah.

VIII PUBLIC KITCHEN AND CLEAN WATER PLACEMENT PLAN

A. Public Kitchen

- 1. Kelurahan Cisaranten Kulon:
 - The area in front of the Arcamanik Sub-district office for the people of RW 01, 02, 03, 04, and 05;
 - The open space in RW 07 for the victims in RW 06, 07, 08, 11 and 12.
- 2. Kelurahan Cisaranten Bina Harapan: in the open spaces in RW 05 to serve the victims in RW 03, 04, 05, and 10.
- 3. Kelurahan Sukamiskin: in the open spaces of RW 02 for the flood victims of RW 01 and 02.

B. Clean Water Placement (PDAM)

- 1. Kelurahan Cisaranten Kulon:
 - The area in front of the Arcamanik Sub-district office for the people of RW 01 and 02;
 - The area in front of the Cisaranten Kulon Kelurahan Office for the people of RW 03, 04 and 05;
 - The open space in RW 07 for the victims in RW 06, 07, 08;
 - The area to the right of the DIPARDA office of Province of West Java to serve the people of RW 11 and 12.

- 2. Kelurahan Cisaranten Bina Harapan:
 - The open spaces of RW 05 for the victims in RW 03, 04 and 05;
 - Near the schoolyard of Bina Harapan Primary School for the victims from RW 10;
- 3. Kelurahan Sukamiskin: located in the residential area of PT. Sari Mas to serve the victims from RW 01 and 02.

IX FLOOD DISASTER MANAGEMENT OPERATORS

The integrated implementation of flood disaster management is carried out by:

- 1. The SATLAK PB (DM Executive Unit) of the Municipality of Bandung (Mayor's Decree, December 1st 1998 No. 360/SK.634-Mawil Hansip);
- 2. DM Operational Unit for the Arcamanik Sub-district (Chief of Arcamanik Sub-district, December 17th 1998 No. 360/SK.66-Cam);
- 3. Community Protection Units of the local kelurahan;

X FLOOD DISASTER MANAGEMENT COMMAND POSTS

In order to support flood management, the following command posts are established:

- a) The sub-district Flood Disaster Operation Center is established at the Sub-district Office with the Head of the Sub-district Mawil Hansip as the responsible person assisted by six officials in charge of data collection, operations, logistics, *tramtib*, information, documentation and rehabilitation.
- b) The kelurahan Flood Disaster Operation Center is established at the meeting room of the local Lurah with the Head of Community Protection (Linmas) Unit/Hansip Task Force in charge with obligation to collect disaster data, Linmas potentials, tools and maintenance.
- c) Strategic command posts are situated at the flood disaster areas (RT/RW).

XI FLOOD DISASTER MANAGEMENT TIME OF IMPLEMENTATION

Flood disaster management is implemented at every opportunities, before, during, and after the disaster occurs. The flood disasters are predicted to occur approximately between December 1998 through January 1999 and enduring up to March 1999.

XII FUNDING

Flood disaster management implementation is financed by the Government of the Bandung Municipality (via the Municipality Budget) and/or from the community.

XIII REPORT

- 1. Reporting procedures:
 - a) Local Lurah report the development of the flood disaster situation and the efforts to mitigate it to the Camat as the head of the DM Operational Unit.
 - b) As the head of the DM Operational Unit, the Camat reports the development of the flood disaster situation and the counter actions to the Mayor of the Bandung Municipality as the chief of SATLAK PB.
- 2. Disaster report formats:
 - 1) Daily report;
 - 2) Weekly, tri-monthly, and annual report;
 - 3) Disaster occurrence report:
 - a. Preliminary report (via the telephone or facsimile)
 - b. The complete report
- 3. The contents of the reports are:
 - 1) Type of disaster;
 - 2) Location of the disaster;
 - 3) Disaster time of occurrence;
 - 4) The number of victims of the disaster;
 - 5) The counter actions already implemented;
 - 6) Request for assistance
- 4. Dissemination of the information on the flood disaster and its counter actions to certain related institutions by the municipal mayor as one of his authorities as the head of SATLAK PB.

XIV FINAL WORDS

This Standard Operating Procedure of the Arcamanik Sub-district was formulated in response to the wet season influenced by the La Nina Phenomenon that will occur in 1998/1999. May Allah bless all our efforts always.

- 1. On Thursday, November 9th 2000 at 14.00 WIB, the *kirmir* of Citepus River collapsed for as long as 12 meters, located in Bima Street of the Kelurahan Arjuna of Cicendo Subdistrict, Bandung. The incident was resolved by the Irrigation Infrastructure Project of the Public Works Department for Irrigation of Bandung City (with photographs enclosed).
- 2. On Monday, November 12th 2000, the *kirmir* of Ciparungpung River collapsed for as long as 7 meters, located in RT 03, RW 06 of Kelurahan Pasir Layung of Cibeunying Kidul Sub-district. The incident will be resolved by BPSDA (Water Resource Development Office) for the Citarum Region.
- 3. During the very same time, water inundated for 4 (four) hours reaching 40 cm deep at the junction of Rumah Sakit Street and Gede Bage Road due to a jam in the Cinambo River culvert. The solution was to excavate and clean the area, especially at the entrance and exit of the culvert.

4. Weather report

a. Average temperature: 25 °C; Lowest: 23 °C; Peak: 28 °C

b. Average atmospheric humidity: 74%; Lowest 58%; Peak: 90 %
