

- **History:** Independent since 9 September 1991
- **Territory:** 143.100 sq. km. (93% mountainous, 40% of Japan)
- **Population:** 7.1 million (2004)



About Tajikistan – Country Profile

- **Climate:**
Midlatitude continental, dry with hot summers and cold winters;
- **Natural resources:**
uranium, mercury, brown coal, lead, zinc, antimony, silver, gold, some petroleum
- **Nationality:**
Tajikistani
- **Ethnic groups:**
Tajik 64.9%, Uzbek 25%, Russian 3.5% other 6.6%
- **Languages:**
Tajik (official), Russian

Natural Disasters in Tajikistan

- Earthquakes, flood/mudslides, drought and winter disasters
- 1,470 catastrophic zones identified
- Damage (Jan – Jun2005):
52 million somonies = 17 million US dollars



Types of Disasters in Percentages (2004)





Disaster Risk Management in Tajikistan

- Identification of areas at risk, forecasting and warning
- Prevention and reduction of consequences of disasters
- Implementation of civil defense training to officials and population
- Organization and training of rescue teams
- Needs assessment in emergencies and distribution of aid
- Rescue of victims and expert recommendations
