Legal basis for establishment of Rural Rescue Teams

Law of the Kyrgyz Republic:

«On search-and-rescue services and rescuer status»
(Chapter 2, Article 7, Paragraph 1)

Search and Rescue services and Search and
Rescue formations could be established:

- On regular staff basis;
- On free lance basis;
- *On voluntary basis.*




Mitigation projects

Findings

- Unawareness of population on hazards and risks
- Disaster risk reduction activities are not implemented at the local level
- Risks are not taken into consideration during planning process
- No early warning mechanisms
- Lack of human and financial resources at the local level
- Financial dependence from public authority on disaster prevention and response
- Labor migration

Further actions

- Certification of Rural Rescue Teams
- Inclusion of Rural Rescue Teams into the state system of population protection
- Exhibition on wheels
- Open air lessons for schoolchildren
