# **Background - Common Challenges**

- Under threats of natural disasters such as earthquakes, typhoons, floods, sediment related disasters and tsunamis.
- The risk is expected to rise
  - -water related disasters : typhoons, floods
  - -sediment related disasters
  - in the changing environment for disaster management such as climate change and rapid urbanization.

Trilateral Joint Announcement on Disaster Management Cooperation

- —shared the view on the importance of promoting trilateral cooperation on disaster management.
- -agreed to enhance co-operations:
  - 1 Developing comprehensive disaster management framework
  - 2 Developing measures and systems to reduce vulnerability to disasters and to minimize damage from disasters
  - 3 Strengthening effective disaster management at the national, local and community levels
- agreed to hold trilateral heads of government agency and expert level meetings on disaster management in rotation

- -on the countermeasures to the disasters which are expected to increase due to climate change
- -to promote earthquake-proofing of buildings
- -to utilize satellite technologies for disaster management
- > Further trilateral cooperation on disaster management
- -Holding expert-level seminars on the training for human resources of disaster management
- -Strengthening cooperation with international disaster management organizations located in three countries and in international disaster management conferences to be held in the three countries
- > The next meeting will be held in 2011 in China.
