

# My work in DRR before joining the VR Program

- Implemented Govt. of India UNDP DRR Program in the State of HP (2010-12) as State Project Officer
- Brought DRR on the table of discussion in the State of HP
- For the first time State and District Level Disaster Management Plans were made
- Drafted the State Policy on DM
- Revised State Relief Manual as DM and Relief Manual
- Co-drafted TNA document of the State and Started training program on DM in various Sectors
- A lot of IEC material was developed for the first time in the State
- A lot of studies on various aspects of DRR/DM were initiated
- Website of State DM Authority was developed and launched
- Got approved Model Building Bye-laws for safe construction practices in the State for adoption by the Local Urban Development Authorities
















# School Safety Project

Developing Upgraded models of school structure in rural areas through existing innovative developed concepts











