#### Introduction

- □ Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) as executive department supervising local governments
- Local Government Academy (LGA) as attached agency of DILG providing and overseeing capacity development for local governments and DILG personnel
- ☐ Operation L!STO as primary capacity development program enhancing local government's capacity on DRRM and CCAM







#### Role of DILG in DRRM-CCAM

- Vice-Chair for Disaster Preparedness of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (RA 10121)
- Member of the Cabinet Cluster on Climate Change Adaptation, Mitigation and Disaster Risk Reduction (CCAM-DRR) (EO24)

## Disaster Preparedness Manuals

- Need-to-do list with codified actions for (i) early preparedness, (ii) minimum critical preparedness, and (iii) early recovery and rehabilitation
- Intended for varied users: Local Chief Executives (LCEs), Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officers (LDRRMOs), and Barangays (Villages)















#### **Minimum Critical Action**

Flow Charts based on Two (2) Scenarios

**ALPHA - DISTANT TSUNAMI** 

ASSUMPTION: 2 hours before tsunami reaches shore


**BRAVO - LOCAL TSUNAMI** 


ASSUMPTION: 20 minutes before tsunami waves hit shore



#### ASSUMPTION: 2 hours before tsunami reaches shore







Activate Tsunami Contingency Plan

- Activate Barangay ICS
- Activate Tsunami Partnership Agreements
- · Deployment of clusters for response
- · Ready the Evacuation Center
- · Secure the Evacuation Route
- Mobilize response teams and other resources
- Activate emergency telecommunications system
- Advice boat owners already at the sea to go to deeper waters
- Activate community warning, sirens and pre-recorded instructions for evacuation

Barangay officials conduct headcount of residents to ensure all are accounted for


Barangay officials assist the residents with their needs in the evacuation area

## On Using the Manuals

- For periodic inward evaluation and reference for planning during peacetime
- For **critical action** upon warning of science agencies, as **monitored** by DILG
- For **reference** of elected officials and non-technical personnel



















#### On Facilitating Wider Use of Manuals

- ✓ Shifted away from manual-specific learning activities in 2023 and organized 98 trainers on 2023
- ✓ 300 LGUs across all regions trained on all manuals on 2023, increased coverage by close to 90% of LGUs in 2024
- ✓ Embedded in other advocacy work at various degrees (e.g., Newly-Elected Officials Orientation in 2019 and 2022, 3R Campaign of DOST-PHIVOLCS in 2023, Project #MAGHANDA of DOST-PAGASA in 2022, etc.)







## **Summary & Ways Forward**

- 1. **Operation LISTO** is a broader capacity development program, with hazard-specific manuals as need-to-lists and codified actions.
- 2. Preparedness needs to evolve to address **complex**, **cascading**, and **co-located** hazards.
- 3. Preparedness hinges on meaningful participation of **barangays**, **civil society**, and **vulnerable groups**.
