**Today's Relief Activities**

- 4 a. **KPK**
- (1) Army Engineers have established 4x Foot Bridges at Madyan, Kalam and Behrain
  - (2) Repair of Bridge at Bagh Deli (Swat) has been completed.
  - (3) Ali Masjid bridge at Khyber Agency on Pak-Torkham road has been repaired and traffic is restored.
  - (4) 3x PAF MI-17 helicopters dropped MREs in Kalam and surrounding areas and evacuated 34 individual.
- b. **Punjab**
- (1) 3 x C-130 Sorties of PAF carrying 100 tents, 7800 kgs flour and pulses each, 140 sacks of rice, 500 packets of dry milk and 5 cartons of medicines reached Multan.
  - (2) 330 x Tents were transported to Dera Ghazi Khan and 100 to Rahim Yar Khan through a C-130 sortie.
- c. **Sindh.**
- (1) Pakistan Navy's search and rescue teams continued their operations in flood affected areas, so far 24000 individual have been rescued by these teams
  - (2) PDMA Sindh despatched 4100 tents, 10 boats, 2000 cartons of dry ration, 1000 bottles of drinking water, 750 soaps and towel each and 37000 P/mats.
  - (3) 6x C-130 sorties of PAF carrying 28 boats, 135 pack of medicines, 4125 liters of mineral water and 19 member medical team reached Sukkur.
- d. **Balochistan.** PRCS is catering for food / healthcare requirements of population of affected areas for next three months.
- e. **AJ&K.** Efforts continued to restore Neelum Valley road.
- f. **GB.** Army has established a Flood Control Centre at Abbottabad for relief of flood affectees in Gilgit and AJ&K. 8x Helicopters are employed for the purpose.
