Subject: **SOUTHWEST MONSOON-2012: DAILY FLOOD SITUATION REPORT  
SUMMARY OF IMPORTANT EVENTS AS ON 15.09.2012.**

**RAINFALL/FLOOD SITUATION IN THE COUNTRY**

Rainfall occurred at most places over Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, West Bengal & Sikkim, northeastern states, west coast and Andaman & Nicobar Islands; at many places over Jammu & Kashmir, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Chhattisgarh, Odisha and Lakshadweep; at a few places over Madhya Pradesh, east Rajasthan, Madhya Maharashtra and coastal Tamilnadu and at one or two places over rest parts of the country outside west Rajasthan, interior Andhra Pradesh and Marathwada where weather remained mainly dry. The chief amounts of rainfall (4 cm and above) recorded at 0830 hrs IST of today were: Mayabandar-23, Jalpaiguri, Portblair, Cooch Behar and Churk-13 each, Allahabad and Long Island-12 each, Contai-11, Gangtok and Bhiwani-10 each, Darjeeling and Baghdogra- 9 each, Hut bay-8, Amritsar, Tadong, Narnaul and Itanagar-7 each, Rajkot, Fursatganj, Majbat, Balurghat and Agumbe-6 each Mount Abu, Varanasi, Bulsar, Jamshedpur and Kanpur- 5 each and Chennai, Kailashahar, Lucknow, Dehradun, Mahabaleshwar, diamond, Harbour, Haflong and Dharamsala -4 each.

**Indian Meteorological Department (Major features of weather forecast)**

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over east Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Sub-Himalyan West Bengal & Sikkim and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Western Himalayan region, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, west Uttar Pradesh, east Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, west coast, Lakshadweep and northeastern states.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Punjab, east Rajasthan, west Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat and Tamilnadu.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over rest parts of the country.

**CENTRAL WATER COMMISSION (daily water levels and forecasts for level forecast sites)**

- There are 06 Moderate flood situation sites in the country as on 15.09.2012.

**DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF)**

12 Teams consisting of 358 personnel of NDRF have been deployed in Assam -03, Andhra Pradesh-01, Maharashtra-03, Uttarakhand-1 and Bihar-04.

**INDIAN METEOROLOGICAL DEPARTMENT (daily weather report)**

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at most places over east Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Sub-Himalyan West Bengal & Sikkim and Andaman & Nicobar Islands.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over Western Himalayan region, Haryana, Chandigarh & Delhi, west Uttar Pradesh, east Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, west coast, Lakshadweep and northeastern states.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at a few places over Punjab, east Rajasthan, west Madhya Pradesh, Gujarat and Tamilnadu.
- Rain/thundershowers would occur at one or two places over rest parts of the country.

### **Weather Warning**

- **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** would occur at a few places over east Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal & Sikkim and Andaman & Nicobar Islands during next 48 hours.
- **Heavy to very heavy rainfall** would occur at one or two places over Jammu division of Jammu & Kashmir, Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand, north Haryana, west Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Gangetic West Bengal, Assam & Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh and Andaman & Nicobar Islands during next 48 hours.

### **Weather outlook for next two days**

- Rain/thundershowers would occur at many places over west, east & northeast India.
- Considerable decrease in rainfall activity over northwest and adjoining central India.
- Rain/ Thundershowers would occur at one or two places over rest parts of the country.

### **CENTRAL WATER COMMISSION (daily water levels and forecasts for level at forecast sites)**

According to the Central Water Commission (CWC) report dated 15th Sept, 2012 there are 06 Moderate flood situation sites in the country as per the details given below :-

#### **Moderate Flood Site**

##### **Assam**

- River Dhansri(s) at Numaligarh, district Golaghat/Numaligarh, Assam is flowing at 77.93m against the danger level of 77.42m with Falling trend.
- River Jiabharali at Jiabharali (NTX), district Sonitpur/ Balipara, Assam is flowing at 77.45m against the danger level of 77.00m with Rising trend.

##### **Bihar**

- River Bagmati at Benibad, district Muzafferpur/Hayaghat, Bihar is flowing at 48.96 m against the danger level of 48.68 m with Rising trend.
- River Kosi at Basua, district Supaul, Bihar is flowing at 48.24 m against the danger level of 47.75m with Falling trend.

##### **Uttar Pradesh**

- River Ghaghra at Elgin Bridge, district Barabanki, Uttar Pradesh is flowing at 106.24m against the danger level of 106.07 m with Rising trend.

##### **West Bengal**

- River Tista at Demohani, district Jalpaiguri, West Bengal is flowing at 86.00 m against the danger level of 85.95m with Rising trend.

### **DEPLOYMENT OF NATIONAL DISASTER RESPONSE FORCE (NDRF) ON 15th Sept, 2012.**

- ❖ In Assam, 03 teams of 1<sup>st</sup> NDRF consisting of 96 personnel (Kamrup-19, Dhemaji-42 and Sonitpur-35) deployed in connection with flood rescue and relief operations.
- ❖ In Andhra Pradesh, 01 team of 5<sup>th</sup> Bn NDRF consisting of 15 personnel in Guntur along with necessary equipments for emergency response and also imparting DM training to personnel of 10 Bn, NDRF.
- ❖ In Maharashtra, 03 teams of 5<sup>th</sup> Bn, NDRF consisting of 93 personnel in Mumbai deployed for monsoon duty.

- ❖ In Uttarakhand, 01 team of 8<sup>th</sup> Bn NDRF consisting of 43 personnel in Rudarparyag deployed for rescue in c/w cloud burst.
- ❖ In Bihar 04 teams of 9<sup>th</sup> Bn NDRF consisting of 111 personnel (Mujjafarpur-31, Supoul- 30, Gopalganj-29 and Darbhanga-21) deployed for emergency response during monsoon season.
