


I. CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS

17 August 2013

- At 5:00 AM, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) in has developed into a Tropical Depression (TD) and was named "MARING". Public storm warning signal (PSWS) number 1 was raised in Batanes Group of Islands. At 11:00 AM, TD "MARING" slightly accelerated as it moved in East Southeast direction. PSWS over Batanes was lifted.

18 August 2013

- TD Maring was located 540 km East of Itbayat, Batanes, and maintained its strength as it moved in an eastward direction. At 11:15 PM, TD "MARING" further intensified into a Tropical Storm (TS).



19 August 2013

- TS "MARING" maintained its strength and remained almost stationary at 575 km East of Itbayat, Batanes with estimated rainfall amount of 10 - 25 mm per hour (heavy to intense)

20 August 2013

- At 10:00 AM, TS "MARING" maintained its strength as it moved northward with estimated rainfall at 10 - 40 mm per hour (heavy – torrential). Meanwhile, Southwest Monsoon continues to affect Luzon and Visayas.

21 August 2013

- At 4:00 AM, TS "MARING" was estimated at 500 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes with maximum sustained winds of 105 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 135 kph.
- At 10:00 AM, TS "MARING" has accelerated further and is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility

II. EFFECTS

A. INCIDENTS MONITORED (TAB A)

Aside from the widespread floodings monitored in various areas in Luzon **seventeen (19)** other incidents were reported in Regions III, IV-A, IV-B and CAR: **6** landslides, **5** drowning, **5** collapsed structures, 1 vehicular accident, 1 incident wherein people were trapped in a cave and **1** mudslide.

B. AFFECTED POPULATION (TAB B)

- The total number of affected population increased to **402,415 families/ 1,928,685 individuals** in **1,549** barangays of **123** municipalities, **33** cities and **16** provinces of Regions I, III, IV-A, IV-B, CAR, and NCR
- Of the total number affected, **45,766 families / 200,060 persons** are sheltered in **675** evacuation centers (ECs) while **77,348 families/ 400,762 persons** opted to stay with friends or relatives

C. CASUALTIES (TAB C)

The total number of casualties is **65**

D. FLOODED AREAS (TAB D)

- A total of **663 areas** in **92 municipalities/cities** under **Regions I, III, IV-A, IV-B, NCR** were reported flooded.

E. COST OF ASSISTANCE (TAB E)

Php28,253,098.46 worth of relief assistance, medicines and NFIs were provided to the affected areas: **Php12,239,830.12** from DSWD, **PhP2,579,927.39** from DOH, **Php12,969,597.45** from LGUs and **Php463,743.00** from NGOs.

F. COST OF DAMAGES (TAB F)

PhP97,297,506.51 worth of damages to agriculture and infrastructures were incurred in Regions I, IV-A, IV-B and CAR. Of this, damages to infrastructures amounted to **PhP74,809,751.05** while damages to agriculture amounted to **PhP22,487,725.46**

G. DAMAGED HOUSES (TAB G)

A total of **231** houses were damaged with **97 totally** and **134 partially** destroyed in Regions I, III, IV-A and CAR.

H. STATUS OF LIFELINES (TAB H)

- A total of **29 roads** in **Regions I, III, IV-A, V, CAR, and NCR** are still impassable to different types of vehicles due to flooding
- **8** power interruptions were reported in **Regions IV-A and IV-B**

I. STRANDEES

A total of **132** passengers, **1** vessel and **2** motorbancas are still stranded in Coast Guard District Northeastern Luzon and Coast Guard District Bicol.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

NDRRMOC upgraded into an Emergency Operation Center (EOC) under **RED ALERT STATUS** effective 19 August 2013.

Disseminated Weather Bulletins and 24-Hour Public Weather Forecasts to all RDRRMCs/OCDRCs through SMS, facsimile and websites for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal level.
