Total affected areas: 38 provinces, 381 districts, 2,803 sub-districts, 24,294 villages, expected damaged farmland 4,128,373 rai (1,651,634 acres)

Total loss and damage: 3,598,043 people affected, 1,114,628 households, and 96 people died

!!! WARNING !!! Tropical Depression in Gulf and Cool Over Upper Thailand:

Tonight the depression is expected to pass lower southern provinces, Pattani, Songkhla, Phatthalung, Nakorn Sri Thammarat, Satun, Trang, Krabi, Phuket, and Pang Nga. Widespread and heavy rain is likely to hit the South from Suratthani province and the wave height is 3-5 meters in the Gulf. Possible flash flood can happen in Suratthani, Nakorn Sri Thammarat, Phatthalung, Songkhla, Pattani, Yala, Narathiwat, Krabi, Trang and Satun. Residents along eastern south coast should be aware of force wind and high surge inshore. Ships in the Gulf keep ashore over this period.

During 3-4 days, the ridge of intense high pressure from China still covers Thailand, cool and cold weather with windy are likely in upper part of the country with minimum temperature 12-16 C in the upper North and Northeastern, and 6-12 C mountain tops
