The message of the press-service of the Ministry of Emergency (on April, 12th, 2011):

Intensive high waters has flooded settlements of several districts (Zelenovsky, Taskalinsky, Terektinsky, Chingirlausky) in the West Kazakhstan and suburb of the regional center Uralsk. It is evacuated more than three thousand persons. The water level in rivers Ural, Bykovka, Derkul, Ilek, Kaldygayta, Chagan, Chizha-1 and Chizha 2 has risen to three meters per day.

In the regional center and districts 5 objects of public health services and 14 electrosubstations are flooded. In two districts and the regional center it has been disconnected from the electric power more than 5200 houses, 630 subscribers of communication and 768 consumers of gas. According to preliminary data, in zones of flooding the murrain has made: 115 sheep, 95 lambs, 72 pigs and 6 horned cattle.
