

1. Summary of the Survey


Earthquake at the bottom of the Indonesia Ocean has caused tsunami waves that destroyed part of Nanggroe Aceh Darussalam Province and Simeulue District; North Sumatra Province and Nias District. The total lost of life was estimated more than 100.000 inhabitants from this area. The infrastructures in both provinces such as buildings, roads, schools, hospital and other public facilities have also been damaged.

The purpose of survey is to find out the information about the real condition of the inhabitants of Nias, Simeulue and West Aceh Districts after the occurrence of tsunami on December 26, 2004.

1.5 Survey methodology

- Government officers: training/seminar for natural disasters, countermeasures against natural disasters, potential sources and information channel.
