■ Disaster Information as of November 13, 2009

Reuters and RISTEK (Information Center for Research on Natural Disasters, State Ministry of Research and Technology, Republic of Indonesia)

Torrential rains caused floods in the beginning of November 2008. Inundation height is reported to be 2 meters high in the outskirts of Tangerang (Map 1). According to RISTEK, rainfall-induced landslides took place in Tasikmalaja (Map 2) and West Java (Map 3). Yet it remains unclear whether the flood and landslide are linked.

Damages

Death: 48 (The National Disaster Coordination Agency, Quoted in Reuters)

Affected: 77,196 in Jakarta and 218,583 in West Java and Banten Province (Map 4)
